

Premium Rigid Core (PRC) Care & Maintenance Instructions

- Clean dust and debris regularly using a broom or vacuum with soft bristles.
- Immediately clean any spills or liquids.
- Mop as needed using a dampened mop and a vinyl floor-approved cleaner; avoid abrasive implements, waxes, or bleach. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive scrubbing tools. Oil and petroleum-based products can cause surface staining.
- Avoid vacuum cleaners with beater bars and electric brooms with hard plastic bottoms unless padded. Steam cleaners should not be used.
- Use felt protectors or other safeguards under furniture legs, especially those moved frequently. Furniture with casters should have wide, non-staining rubber casters; ball casters are not recommended. For office chairs, use protective mats.
- Avoid dragging heavy objects or furniture across the floor. Use protective items like cardboard when moving appliances or heavy items.
- Place mats at exterior doors to minimize tracked-in dirt and debris. Avoid mats with rubber or latex backs to prevent discoloration or staining of the PRC.
- Do not subject the flooring to temperatures below 5°C (41°F) or create sudden flooring movements.
- Pets with unclipped nails should be prevented from scratching or damaging the floor.
- Minimize direct sunlight exposure; use blinds or drapes during peak hours to protect the floor.
- Avoid sharp edges that can scratch or gouge the floor surface.
- Keep spare planks for potential repairs by a flooring professional in case of accidental damage.
